HOSPICE CARE IN A HOSPITAL SETTING

What type of care will I receive?

While hospice is most often provided in whatever place the patient calls “home,” sometimes a short hospital stay becomes necessary. When a patient’s pain or symptoms are uncontrolled despite active treatment efforts, he or she may receive hospice care in a hospital until their pain and symptoms are under control. This level of care is short-term and is paid for by Medicare, Medicaid, or other private insurances.

During this time, the hospital staff will work alongside the hospice team, who will oversee the patient’s plan of care.

What happens next?

Once a patient’s symptoms have been addressed, they will be discharged to:

- ❖ Their home
- ❖ A nursing facility, such as a nursing home
- ❖ The Angela Hospice Care Center
- ❖ An assisted living program
- ❖ A group home
- ❖ Another residence of the patient’s choice

Medicare does not cover room and board charges in any of these settings.



How Angela Hospice can help

The Angela Hospice Team will assist you with your discharge plans. It is best to begin planning for discharge at the beginning of your hospital stay, as it will be short-term.

Your Angela Hospice social worker will assist you with this transition. We have also included an *Angela Hospice Care Center Admission Information* brochure. If you are interested in the Care Center, an Angela Hospice nurse or social worker will assist you in completing the application.
